- Must demonstrate basic competence in specified nursing skills.
- Must be capable of making independent decisions requiring minimal supervision.
- Must be able to demonstrate basic organizational skills while establishing acceptable priorities and maintaining appropriate flexibility.
- Must possess personality traits compatible with the needs of clients requiring services.
- Must demonstrate the character qualities of diligence, alertness, initiative, decisiveness and orderliness.
- Must exhibit Preferred's customer service philosophy.
- Must be willing to travel extensively in service area.
- Must be able to bend, lift, transfer, climb stairs, and maneuver a client of fifty(50) pounds or more.
- Must be available for on-call work on a rotating basis.
